What is the Ironhorse Ultra 100? The event is an organized footrace in which soloists or teams have the option to run 100 km or 100 miles on one of the most challenging and beautiful off-road courses in Western Canada. As a part of the Alberta Ultra Series the Iron Horse Ultra 100 will test the endurance of all runners. All the challenges of a Mountain course without the Altitude!!

Historical Perspective: The Iron Horse Trail follows the historic Carlton Trail, first documented in the 1790's as a fur trade route. The Carlton Trail linked Eastern and Western Canada and has been referred to as the original Hudson Bay Trail.

BRAND NEW 50 KM RACE

"Whistle Stop 50" offer an alternative to the bigger and sometime intimidating distance, so we are offering a new "try it adventure race" distance.

The whistle stop 50 is designed for new soloist or teams of 5 runners. The minimum age requirement for this race is 12 years and older on race day with parent consent. Each leg for the 50 km event will be 8-12 km in length with varying degree of difficulty.
